

OPPOSE ANTI-IMMIGRATION BILLS, SUPPORT LEGALIZATION

HR 4437 or the Sensenbrenner Bill

- HR 4437 criminalizes anyone who has regular contact with an undocumented person.
- HR 4437 makes it a felony to not have documents, and subjects undocumented people to prison time and deportation.
- HR 4437 allows city, county, and state police officers to receive immigration enforcement training and allows those officers to act as immigration officers (migra).
- HR 4437 would discourage undocumented people to report crimes and come forward as witnesses during police investigations. This affects the safety of all our community, documented and undocumented.
- HR 4437 will divide families by possibly deporting members of families that have been living in the United States for years.
- HR 4437 would make it more difficult for legal permanent residents to obtain citizenship.
- HR 4437 would allow the construction of a 700 mile new fence on the United States-Mexico border.
- HR 4437 would make all employers resubmit their workers' immigration information to the federal government.

Oppose the Specter Bill (Guest Worker Bill)

- Creates a second-class status for immigrant workers and their families.
- Does **not** create a pathway for immigrants to gain citizenship.
- Guest worker program would prevent workers from joining unions and create an environment for employers to abuse their workers.
- Would create a program that allows undocumented people to work for six years and then requires them to return to their country of origin.
- Both HR 4437 and the Specter Bill do not make the border patrol accountable for deaths that occur on the border.
